



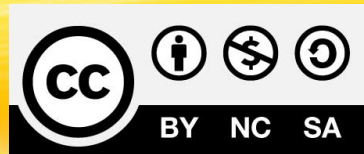

It was a Category 5 hurricane with wind speeds at 175 miles per hour.

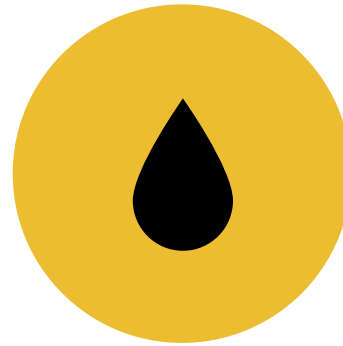

It went down as the 3<sup>rd</sup> strongest hurricane in American history.

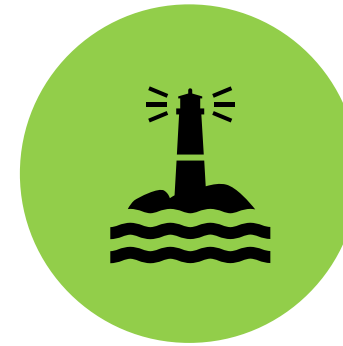
# HURRICANE KATRINA

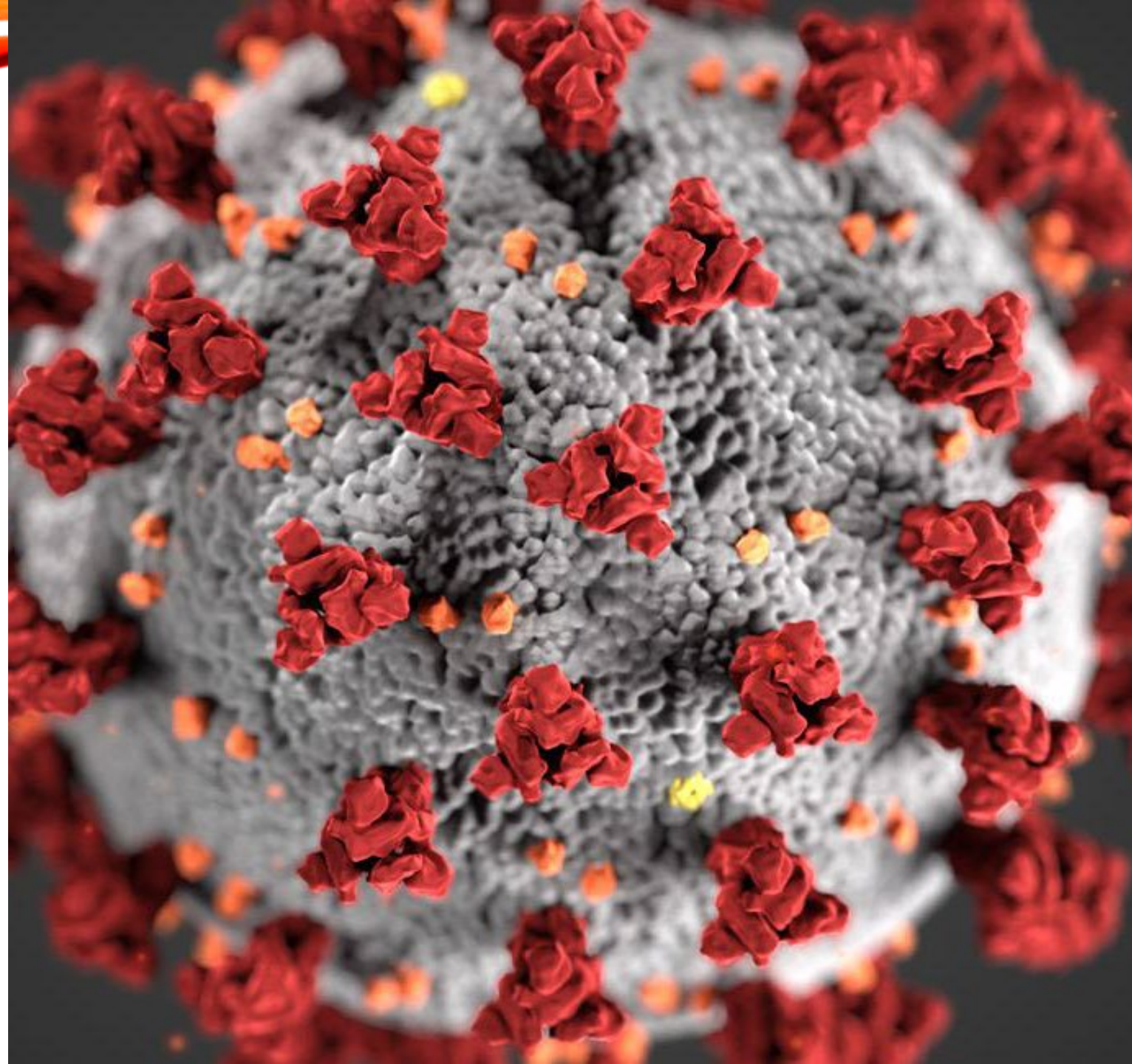

# THE CORONAVIRUS

- The first reported case of the virus came from Wuhan China and claimed the lives of thousands of people.
- The Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness that is highly contagious and more of a danger for the elderly and individuals with pre-existing health conditions.
- Since it was so contagious the number of confirmed cases rose rapidly





# THE CORONAVIRUS

The United States had its first confirmed case in January 2020.

**Jan. 2020**

Today there are approximately 216 countries with cases of the virus.

**Today**

**end of January**

By the end of January, Trump restricted the entry into the United States for individuals who traveled to China in the past 14 days.

**Mar. 2020**

By March 2020 states across the country began shutting down, putting “shelter in place” orders and being urged to quarantine to help stop the spread of the virus.

## THE NEW NORMAL

- The virus is responsible for social distancing where individuals are required to stay at least 6 feet apart in public spaces.
- Civilians are now required to wear face masks in public to prevent spreading the virus.
- People are panicking when people in public cough or sneeze.





# THE CORONAVIRUS

- As of May 15, 2020 there are
  - 4,434,653 confirmed cases around the world.
  - 302,169 deaths
  
- As of May 15, 2020 there are
  - 2,419 newly confirmed coronavirus cases in NYS.
  - 174 deaths on that date
  - Overall, there are 353K confirmed cases and 22,843 deaths

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
