PPT PRESENTATION: SELECT ONE of the topics below

[you may also combine the topics based on your research interests]

- Examine the decolonization movements in Africa, Asia or Latin America, or resistance movements in indigenous communities against invaders, and colonists in the Americas. You may select a specific country to analyze from one of these three regions. Describe why different peoples think, govern themselves, fight and interact with each other the way they do.
- Discuss imperialism, colonialism, nationalism and independence movements, and the impact of revolutions and world wars as they relate to your selected geographical location.
- Explain the significance of major resistance movements that have shaped the world's societies based on the specific geographical location / region/ community / country that you have selected.

Final Exam Requirements: The final exam will consist of both a written research paper and a ppt presentation of the research paper. Footnotes/endnotes citing all sources used must be included using the proper format. A bibliography must also be included. No more than two sources may be from Internet web sites. Any Internet sites must include web addresses. You will present a summary of the paper in a ppt presentation during the last week of classes. The final research paper will be due on the last day of the final exams.
