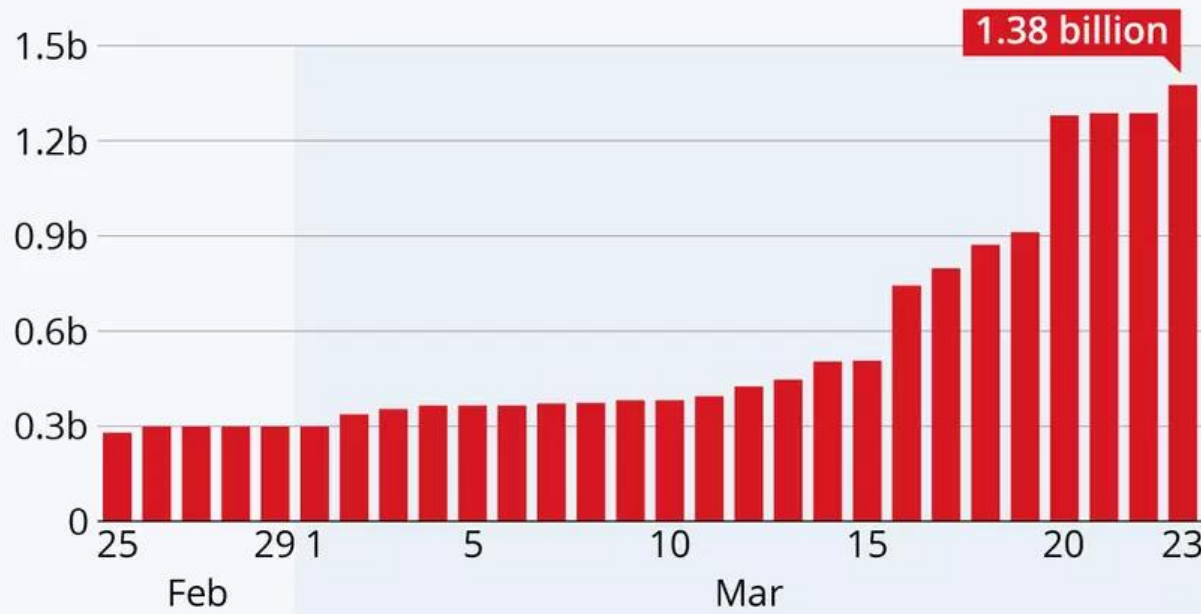
Education

Bribery is the exchange of anything of value for support on a proposal, policy, or vote. A kickback is a kind of bribe in which a politician is guaranteed a commission for approving a contract or policy. Watergate in the 1970s and 2019's Trump-Ukraine scandal are the two instances in US history in which sitting presidents were accused of using the power of the office to tamper with elections and ensure their own victories. Also, Donald Trump in 2019 was also one of three United States presidents to have been **impeached**: Andrew Johnson in 1868, Bill Clinton in 1998.

Political corruption is the use of power by people in government or their associates to illegally or illegitimately benefit themselves. Using public office to gain money, favors, or electoral advantages is political corruption.

Cronyism is the practice of hiring a friend or business associate for reasons other than their qualifications.

Nepotism is appointing family members to positions of political power or influence.

Trump tells 'The Squad' to 'go back' to where they came from

In a controversial tweet in July, the president told “the Squad,” a group of four progressive female lawmakers, to “go back and help fix the totally broken and crime infested places from which they came.”

The Squad consists of Reps. Ilhan Omar (D-Minn.), Rashida Tlaib (D-Mich.), Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (N.Y.) and Ayanna Pressley (D-Mass.), who are all U.S. citizens. All but Omar were born in the U.S.

The president’s remarks sparked bipartisan backlash, and the House passed a resolution condemning his comments and calling them “racist,” days after his initial tweet. Trump would continue to attack with the Squad throughout the rest of the month.

- A pneumonia of unknown cause detected in Wuhan, China was first reported to the WHO Country Office in China on 31 December 2019.
- WHO is working 24/7 to analyze data, provide advice, coordinate with partners, help countries prepare, increase supplies and manage expert networks.
- The outbreak was declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern on 30 January 2020.
- On 11 February 2020, WHO announced a name for the new coronavirus disease: COVID-19

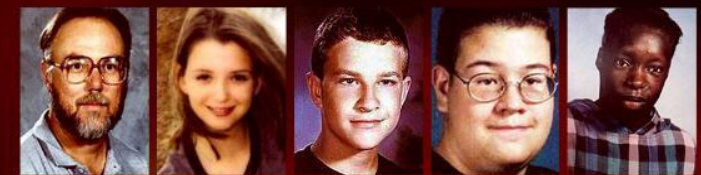
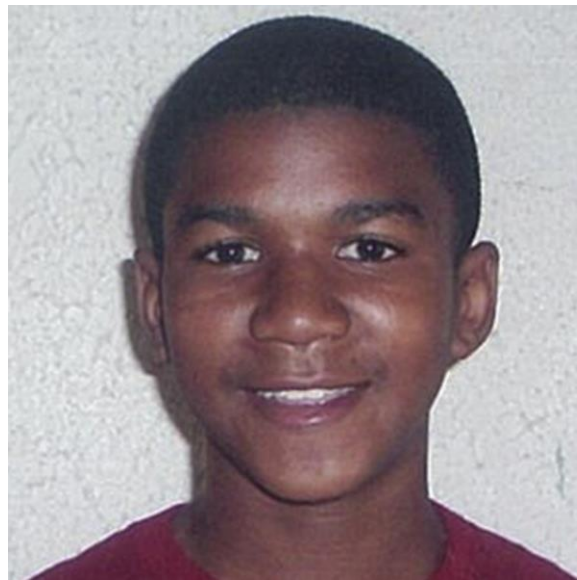
